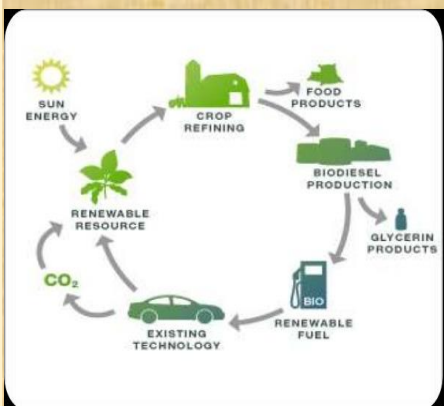


International Biodiesel Day

The most renewable fuel!



Biodiesel is produced from vegetable oils, yellow grease, used cooking oils, or animal fats. The fuel is produced by trans esterification - a process that converts fats and oils into biodiesel and glycerin (a coproduce).



No black exhaust and is healthier.



Reduces green house gases emissions and is eco-friendly.



Better for engines and no engine modification required.



Is safer to use with higher flash points.



Biofuels burn cleaner than gasoline, resulting in fewer **greenhouse gas emissions**, and are fully biodegradable, unlike some fuel additives. Cellulosic ethanol has the potential to cut **greenhouse gas emissions** by up to **86%**.
