4	To promote, Implement and Coordinate Green Skill Development Programme (GSDP)
5	To implement & Coordinate National Environment Survey (NES) -Grid Based Decision Support System (GRIDSS)
6	To participate, implement and Coordinate Community-driven Environmentally Sustainable Village Programme (CESVP) as and when intimated by ENVIS
7	To build a repository and dissemination centre in Environmental Science, Information and Management (ESIM)
8	To enable application of modern technologies of acquisition, processing, storage, retrieval and dissemination of information of environmental nature
9	To support and promote research, development and innovation in ESIM
10	To build a strong, retrieval and dissemination capabilities with the ultimate objective of disseminating
11	To build a strong statistical base such that ENVIS is recognised as a South Asian Hub for ESIM
12	To promote national cooperation and liase with agencies concerned for exchange of environment related information/ To Maintain liaison with International organizations/institutions for exchange of information on Ecology of Eastern Ghats
13	To promote , support and assist education and personnel training programs designed to enhance ESIM capabilities
14	To establish linkages with information users, carriers and providers from among government, academia, business and Non Governmental Organisations including that with ENVIS.
